# Phonics

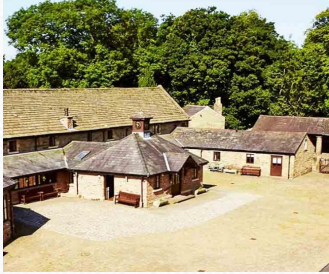
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- New this year. <http://schools.ruthmiskin.com/training/view/bhre4m4g/7Vpv2bhS>
