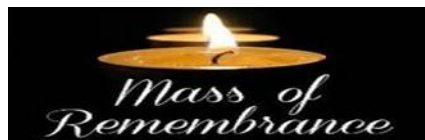

Masses will be celebrated for the pious list each week in November. If you would like to include your loved ones, place your list of names in an envelope marked Pious List with your offering and bring it to church or to the Presbytery

Remembrance Mass: On Tuesday 11th November at 7pm, we will have our annual Service of



Remembrance for those who have died from our parish community over the last 12 months. Their families will be invited to this service where each person who has died will be remembered in prayer and the lighting of a candle. A list is displayed in the Narthex of our parishioners whose funerals have been celebrated in our parish, and their names will be read out. We will pray collectively for all other deceased parishioners.
